## Schedule



### Construction

Stage 0

#### Stage 1

October 2022– April 2023

Enabling work including fiber relocation and temp Ramp ES December 2022– September 2024

Complete future I-495 NB in Median, and Fruit Street, Stage 1

### Stage 2

June 2024– May 2026

Complete future I-495 SB, Ramps WN, WS, ES and SE, Fruit Street, Stage 2 Stage 3/3b

April 2025– April 2027

Complete Ramp NE, NW, SW and EN

Stage 4

August 2026– June 2027

Complete I-90 widening, remove former loop ramps and complete environmental mitigation areas



### Key Project Elements and Proposed Modifications

- Project limits extend approximately 3/4 mile in each direction
- Complete replacement of the Interchange
- Elimination of old toll booth area and weaving areas
- Extremely sensitive environmental resource area

#### MASSACHUSETTS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

### **I-90**

- 3 lanes in each direction
- · Minor widening and minimal changes to profile
- Bridges over MBTA/CSX/Amtrak and Whitehall Brook to be replaced

## I-495

- 3 lanes in each direction
- 4th lane to Route 9
- Future I-495 NB will be within the previous median area
- Future I-495 SB will be in its existing location
- Bridges over MBTA/CSX/Amtrak and I-90 to be replaced





### Interchange Ramps

- New direct, semi-direct and loop ramp configurations
- Support up to 40-50 mph design speed
- Single or two-lane ramps
  based on traffic demand

\*Ramp Designations indicate directionality—i.e., **Ramp WN** connects I-90W to I-495N





# **Fruit Street**

- Will be completed in 2 major stages
- 2-way, 1-lane alternating traffic (under signal control) during major stages

## **Flanders Road**

- Replacement of I-495 NB bridge superstructure over Flanders Road
- · Constructed with an overbuild to maintain 3-lanes of travel
- Utility work on Flanders Road below I-495





### Environmental Considerations

## Interchange is located near sensitive natural resources

- Cedar Swamp ACEC
- Sudbury River
- Whitehall Brook
- Surrounding wetlands and floodplains

#### **Permits**

- Issued during preliminary design
- Require continued agency involvement as designs advance
- Require construction
  and post-construction oversight







# Ongoing/Upcoming Construction Activity

- Future I-495 SB Mainline
- I-495 SB Bridges over I-90 and MBTA
- Fruit Street, Stage 2
- Ramps WS and SE
- Ramp ES
- Ramp WN
- I-495 NB Bridge over Flanders Road
- I-90 over Whitehall Brook, Stages 0 and 1
- I-90 over RR

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## Implementation of I-495 SB Crossover

#### **Implemented Summer 2024**

- I-495 SB traffic shifted to existing median (future I-495 NB)
- I-495 NB traffic remains as today
- Associated I-495 SB
  on/off-ramp modifications





### Fruit Street – Stage 2

#### **Implemented Summer 2024**

- 2<sup>nd</sup> Stage of replacement of Fruit Street bridge over I-495
- Traffic shifted to newly constructed section of bridge
- Remaining existing bridge to be demolished/final construction





# **Ramp ES Opening**

#### Scheduled Opening–Fall 2024

- Proposed ramp provided between I-90 EB and I-495 SB
- Part of a 2-lane off-ramp from I-90 EB (splits to Ramp ES and Ramp EN)
- Combines with future Ramp WS to provide 2-lane on-ramp to I-495 SB





### I-90 over Whitehall Brook

- Bridge carrying I-90 over Whitehall Brook to be reconstructed in multiple stages
- Requires traffic shifts along I-90 EB and WB
- Requires modifications to I-90 WB
  on-ramp and I-90 EB off-ramp





### I-90 over Whitehall Brook Stage 0/1

#### Stage 0/1 Fall/Winter 2024

- Stage 0 involves I-90 roadway grading, median reconstruction and drainage work
- Stage 1 requires traffic shifts along I-90 EB (to the north)–crossing constructed to the south
