### What is an MPO?

A federally required planning entity that engages governments (elected officials and various transportation agencies), residents, and other stakeholders in a **collaborative and transparent public process** to:

Transportation Improvement Program Rolling, five-year capital investment plan, including the shorterterm investments that help realize the long-term vision

- Allocates all federal highway and transit funds
- Includes projects prioritized by MPO, MassDOT, MBTA, MWRTA, and CATA





Transportation Funding in Massachusetts

> Regional TIP = All projects in region funded using federal highway and transit funds

- Statewide TIP (STIP) = Compilation of all TIPs from each of 13 Mass. MPOs
- Statewide CIP = All projects in Mass. funded using both federal AND state funds


Local funds, public/ private grants, etc.







## Looking Ahead

- Higher annual funding levels anticipated to continue in coming years
  - Pipeline of projects is relatively limited, given recent influx of funding
  - Begin project development now for consideration in next year's TIP
- New federal discretionary programs in the BIL
  - MassDOT working to develop regional and statewide strategies for pursuing grants, in partnership with RTAs, MPOs, municipalities
